Who-- কে

Structure: Who+verb+----?

1. Rabby sang a song? Ans: Who sang a song?

2. Beauty made a good result. Ans: Who made a good result?

Everybody/Everyone= Who does not...?

Everybody wishes to be happy. Ans: Who does not wish to be happy?

Nobody/none= Who+verb..?

Nobody believes a liar. Ans: Who believes a liar?

Where---কোথায়---

Structure: Where+ auxiliary verb+subject+main verb+object---?

He went to America. Ans: Where did he go?

They will go to Dhaka. Ans: Where will they go?

He goes to school. Ans: Where does he go?

They go to market. Where do they go?

The seminar was held in Sylhet. Where was the seminar held?

When---কখন-সময়

Structure: When+ auxiliary verb+subject+main verb+object---?

They will go there tomorrow. Ans: When will they go there?

They came here yesterday. Ans: When did they come here?

They come here every day. Ans: When do they come here?

He goes to college in the morning. Ans: When does he go to college?

The seminar was held yesterday. When was the seminar held?

He was born in 1999. When was he born?

Time--সময়

সময় থাকলে What time is it now? বসবে।

It is 4pm now. Ans: What time is it now?

It is quarter to ten now. Ans: What time is it now?

Whom-কাকে?

Structure: Whom+ auxiliary verb+subject+main verb+object---?

He wants her. Ans: Whom does he want?

They wanted him. Ans: Whom did they want?

Why-কেন?

Structure: Why+ auxiliary verb+subject+main verb+object---?

Sylhet is famous for tea gardens. Ans: Why is Sylhet famous?

He went to bus station to receive his friend. Why did he go to bus station?

He goes to college to study. Ans: Why does he go to college?

What—কি?

Subject বস্তু হলে what বসে। আর ব্যক্তির নাম থাকলে Who বসে।

Corruption is a curse. Ans: What is corruption?

Football is my favourite game. Ans: What is your favourite game?

Object বস্তু হলে what বসে।

She likes flowers. Ans: What does she like?

How---কিভাবে/কেমন

Structure: How+ auxiliary verb+subject+main verb+object---?

He goes to school on foot. Ans: How does he go to school?

He killed the bird with a gun. Ans: How did he kill the bird?

They are very fine. Ans: How are they?

She looks beautiful. Ans: How does she look?

He did the work carefully. Ans: How did he do the work?

They go to Dhaka by train. Ans: How do they go to Dhaka?

How much--কত দাম/uncountable noun

They want 500 taka. Ans: How much money do they want?

This shirt will cost you tk. 1000. Ans: How much money will this shirt cost you?

How many--সংখ্যা/countable noun

I have two brothers. How many brothers do you have?

I need ten books. Ans: How many books do you need?

How far--দূরত্ব

Dhaka is 400 miles from Sylhet. Ans: How far is Dhaka from Sylhet?

How long--কোন দৈর্ঘ্য, দীর্ঘ সময়

They have been waiting for two years. How long have they been waiting?

He has been reading for three hours. Ans: How long has he been reading?

How old—বয়স বুঝলে

She is twenty years old. Ans: How old is she?

How fast---কত দ্রুত

He runs 8 kilometers per hour. Ans: How fast does he run?

Which--কোনটি

Structure: Which+বস্তু+ auxiliary verb+subject+main verb+object+---?

He likes this shirt. Ans: Which shirt does he like?

They want this house. Ans: Which house do they want?

Whose--কার

Structure: Whose+বস্তু+ auxiliary verb+subject+main verb+object+---?

He wants his father's car. Ans: Whose car does he want?

I want the pen of my friend. Ans: Whose pen do you want?
